

# SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO DOCENT SOCIETY

## STANDING RULES

1. These rules govern the day-to-day operations of the Society. The Standing Rules will be published each year in the first CAPsule newsletter of the year and in the yearly Directory.
2. The dues of the Society shall be \$25.00 per year, payable January First. A minimum training fee shall be \$25.00 per person, payable by the second training session.
3. The Docent Dress Code is as follows: Dress is to be a mixture of white, black, and red (Christmas red). Avoid casual dress/no shorts. Standard dress has been designated as black Spanish-style hat, red blazer or black vest, white or red blouse/shirt, black skirt/trousers, black shoes/boots.
4. Each Docent is responsible for purchasing a Docent hat as prescribed in the Docent Dress Code. Hats can be purchased from the board and will be sold at the Society's cost.
5. Classes of membership are:
  - A. **Docent:** Walks the path of historic San Juan Capistrano, gives a minimum of 12 tours per year or equivalent service at historic sites and or museums and attends at least four Docent General Meetings per year or other education opportunities, e.g. field trips, lectures, meetings, and activities.
  - B. **Sustaining:** Does not tour or do service hours but contributes financially to the Society.
